These books are on EVERYONE'S summer reading list this year. From spicy romance to memorable non fiction, you'll find a little bit of everything here.



Funny Story by Emily Henry (Romance) After their exes hook up with each other, two heartbroken acquaintances move in together and form a warm friendship and ...something more?

Nightwatching by Tracy Sierra A home invasion has a mother and her kids trapped during a blizzard. Sleep with the lights on after this one.




Middle of the Night by Riley Sager (Thriller) It's a spooky story about an unsolved mystery, childhood friendships, and dark secrets.





