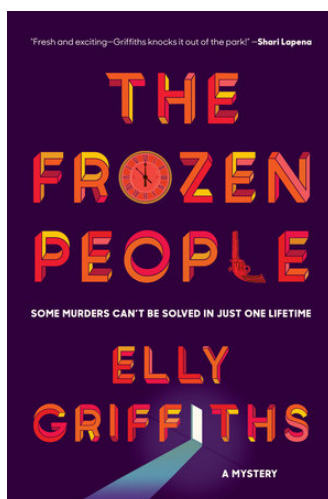
## Staff Recommendations

I'm so so excited that the final book in the Kindred's Curse saga, *Burn of the Everflame*, is finally out. I fell in love with this series two years ago and have been desperately waiting since.

This slow burn romantasy features an unlikely heroine coming into her power, found family, and a wonderfully unique magic system.

Ali Dawson and her team of British detectives investigate cold cases using secret techniques: traveling back in time to investigate and sometimes even witness these cold cases.

When Ali goes to 1850s London, she finds herself entangled in the mysterious circumstances and unable to get back to the present. I

loved this fun, unique premise that reads like several different genres mashed together.



### Library Assistant Emily's Pick

This memoir translates the unique experience of deafness, deaf culture, and what it means to live in a 'hearing world' so well. Novic blends an immersive history and explanation of institutionalized barriers for deaf peoples with her personal story, weaving a tale that is both a beautiful self expression and an educational tool we all could use.
